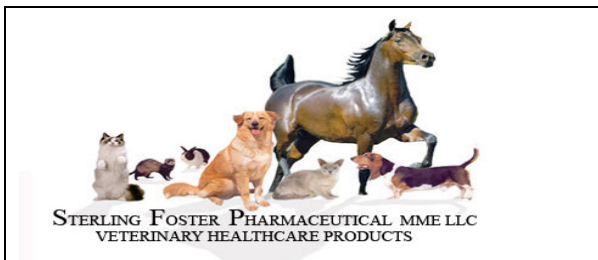

Just as with their owners, vomiting and diarrhea in pets is very common and most of the time it is self-limited one spontaneously resolving in time.

Gastralox is a supplement-based product, patented and formulated with ingredients design to maintain normal GI (gastro-intestinal) function especially in the presence of vomiting or diarrhea.

Generally speaking the phyto-therapeutic (plant derived) agents in Gastralox are specific for the lining of your pets' stomach and colon. The GI tract has its own methods of protection, chief of which are 1) a "slimy" mucus coating and 2) a system of rapid cellular replacement, that is, a system for replacing any damaged cells within its lining. When the mucus coat thins, the cellular lining is exposed and often time damaged. Generally, vomiting and diarrhea will follow.

WHEN TO SEE A VETERINARIAN FOR VOMITING AND DIARRHEA?

"whenever you feel it's unsafe for your pet "

Of course this is the safest answer. However based on the nature of vomiting and diarrhea in pets there are some other points to consider which will save you time, expense and minimize the suffering in your pet.

Why Pets Vomit or Have Diarrhea

Whenever your pet vomits or have diarrhea, it may be a sign of serious disease, requiring immediate veterinary attention. However, as many veterinarians would advise, most bouts of vomiting and diarrhea in pets is often due to self-limited factors that in time, 1-2 days, will correct themselves.

Often vomiting or diarrhea results from dietary indiscretion, rapid ingestion of food or over eating. At times brief viral illness not unlike that which occasionally affects the owner, may occur. When vomiting or diarrhea occurs, a complete bowel rest is in order; either amount, frequency or composition of feeding has to be changed.

While the owners have non-prescription medications that they take for minor causes of vomiting and diarrhea, pets do not. **Gastralox** fills this need experienced so often by pets and pet owners....the need of having on hand a product formulated specifically for vomiting or diarrhea in pets. And **Gastralox** will not mask disease, so you can feel safe; and it is rapidly effective.

So When Should See a Veterinarian

If you see blood in the vomit or in the diarrhea, then seek immediate veterinary attention; any projectile (shooting) vomiting or diarrhea warrants professional attention. If your pet appears to have a fever or is tender to touch in the stomach are or is listless or has stomach bloating seek emergent veterinary attention. The odor or appearance of stool in the vomit requires an immediate vet visit.

More often than not, however, the pet with vomiting and diarrhea will have a self-limited problem that requires a common sense approach of bowel rest and the appropriate GI (gastro-intestinal) product, such as **Gastralox**
